A textbook definition:

Low code is **a way of software development** that aims to build advanced applications with **less programming work** and with **less specialized programming knowledge**.

No code is the same, but **without** programming and knowledge.





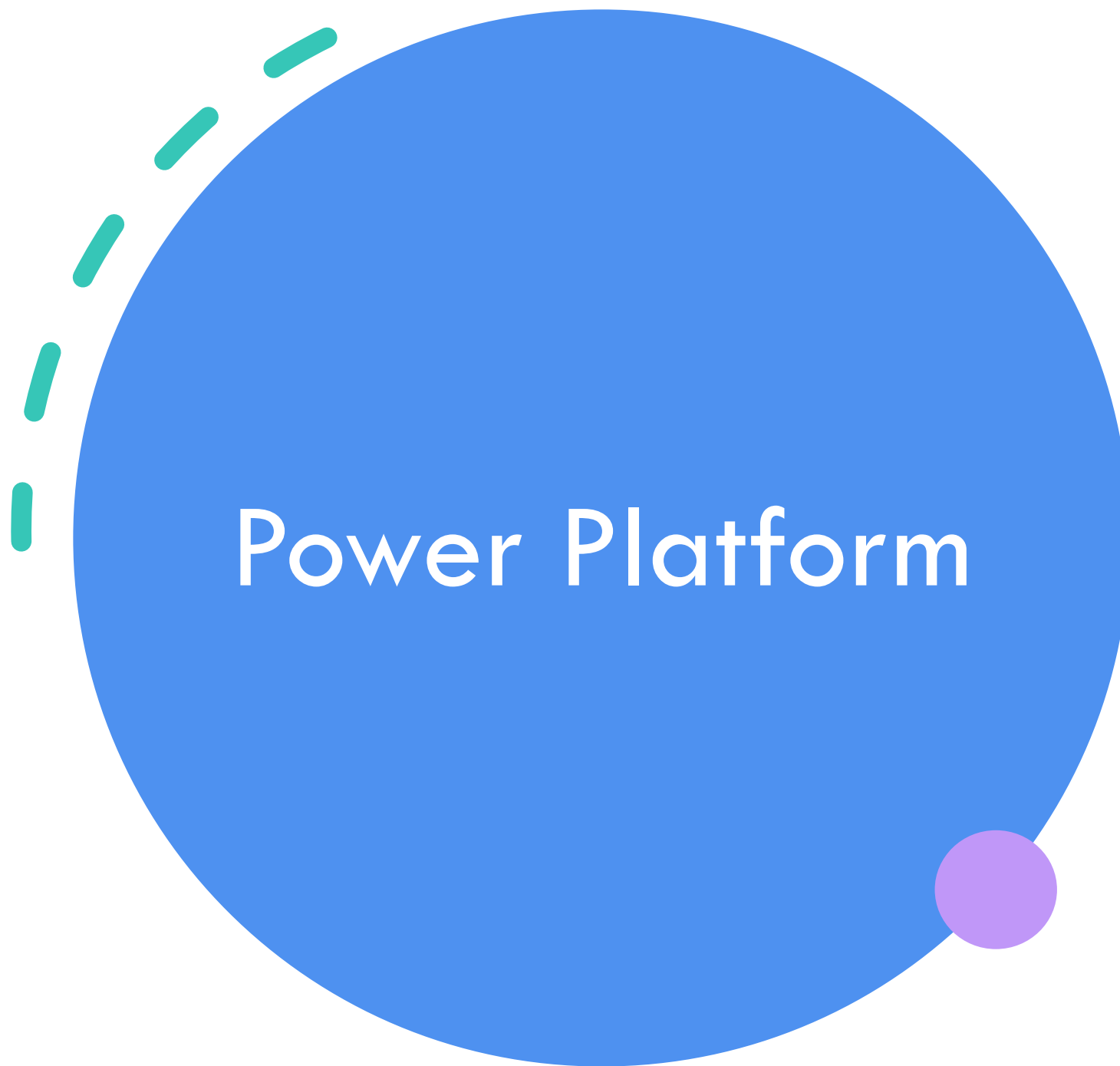
Why?

There is an increasing demand for digital solutions, a demand that IT services find difficult to keep up with.

Drag and drop experiences that are like PowerPoint



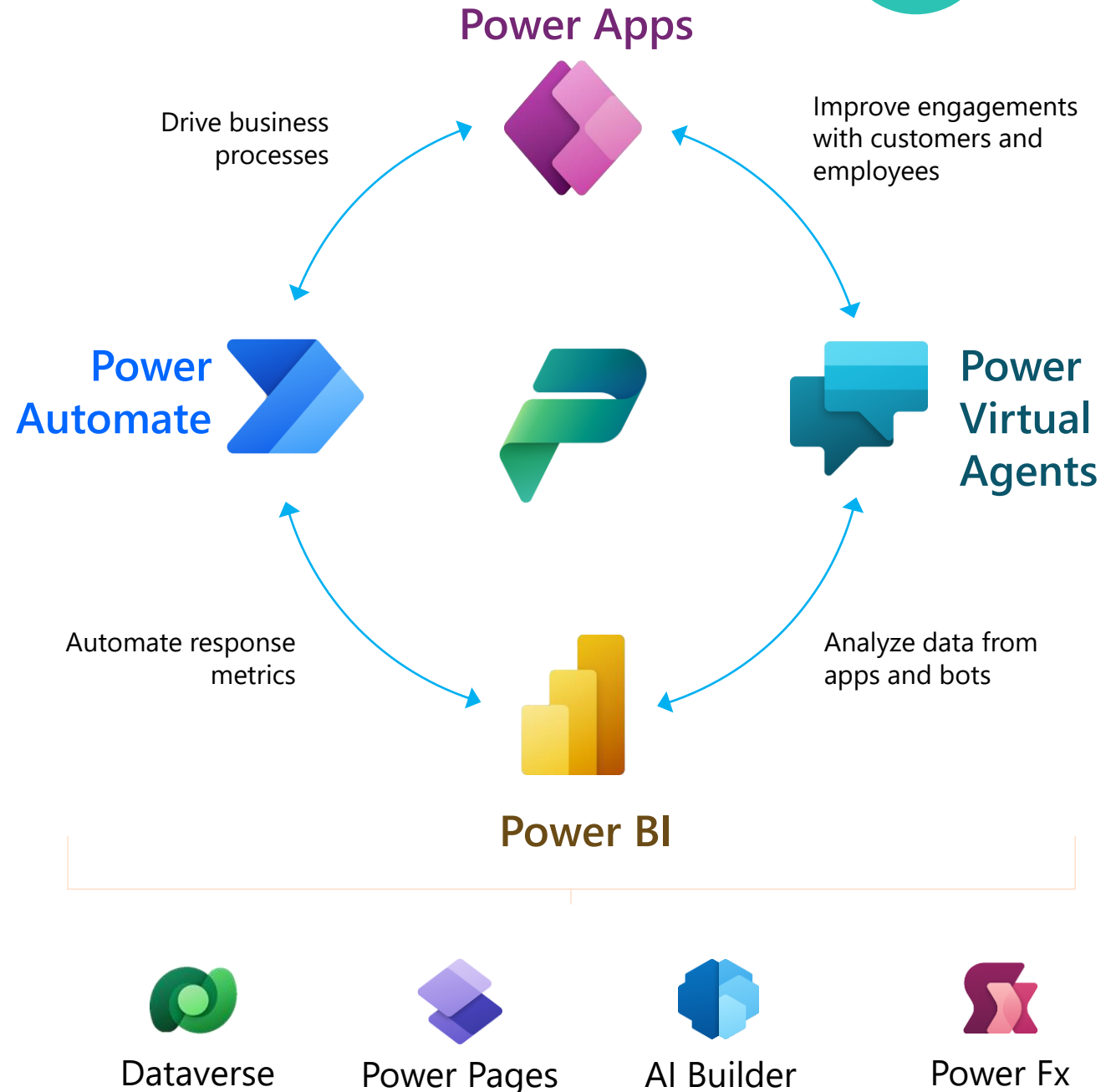
